Knight Masons of the USA ANSON JONES COUNCIL NO.47 BY-LAWS

ADOPTED MARCH 21, 1992 Revised November 15, 2006 Revised March 1, 2009 Revised November 11, 2020

ARTICLE I - NAME

- a) The name of this Council shall be Anson Jones Council No. 47, Knight Masons.
- b) It shall be located at Houston (city) in Harris County, Texas (state)
- c) It holds its Charter from, and owes fealty and allegiance to the Grand Council of Knight Masons of the United States of America and to the Most Worshipful Grand Lodge of Texas, A.F. & A.M.

ARTICLE II - MEETINGS

The stated meetings of this Council shall be held quarterly at the will of the Excellent Chief, preferably in the months of January, March, August and November. The last stated meeting in each calendar year shall be the Annual Meeting for election of officers. Special Meetings may be held at the time and place designated by the Excellent Chief.

ARTICLE III - OFFICERS AND COMMITTEES

- a) The following Officers shall be elected and installed each year and shall serve until their successors are duly elected and installed: Excellent Chief, Senior Knight, Junior Knight, Scribe, and Treasurer.
- b) The following officers shall be appointed by the Excellent Chief and shall serve at his pleasure: Senior Warden, Junior Warden, Director of Ceremonies, Priest, Steward, and Sentinel. (See Article XVII of the STATUTES).
- c) The Excellent Chief may appoint such committees as may be useful for carrying on the Council's affairs. The Excellent Chief shall be, *ex officio*, a member of all committees.

ARTICLE IV - MEMBERSHIP

- a) Membership in this Council shall be by invitation only. To be eligible for membership candidates must be Royal Arch Masons in good standing in Lodge and Chapter. Good standing in the prerequisite Bodies is necessary for continuing membership. (See Article IX and Article XII of the STATUTES).
- b) Invitations for membership shall be given after unanimous election by the Council using secret ballot or ballot by first class mail. If an invitation is not accepted within three years of its date of issue, such invitation shall be rendered null and void. However, the individual may be reproposed at a later date and he must be re-elected by ballot.

ARTICLE V - FEES AND DUES

a) The Dues and Fees of this Council may be set by a 2/3 vote of the Members present at a Stated Meeting of the Council from time to time as may be required for the operation of the Council. (Currently as of June 2009 Dues are \$15.00 and Fees are set at \$200.00 per person) (not less than \$20.00 See article XII of the STATUTES)

b) A member in good standing may become a life-member of this council by the payment of \$300 (not less than 20 times annual dues) to the Life Membership Fund. (See Article XIII of the STATUTES)

ARTICLE VI - LOCAL REGULATIONS

- a) The fee for the degrees shall include apron, sash, jewel, lapel pin, and the initial annual dues.
- b) The affiliation fee in this council for single, dual, or plural membership shall be the annual dues plus \$10.
- c) The officers and members of this council shall clothe themselves in their appropriate regalia for all meetings of the council which includes, apron, sash, and jewel. Members are encouraged to be clothed in tuxedo or business suit.
- d) Because of the Irish Heritage of the Order, a festive board shall be held on or near St. Patrick's Day, March 17th, of each year.
- e) A retiring Excellent Chief shall receive a Past Excellent Chief's Jewel from the Council.

ARTICLE VII - TERMINATION

In the event this Council shall cease to exist, except for the purpose of consolidation or merger, the Excellent Chief, Scribe, and Treasurer shall, within 30 days thereafter, transmit to the Grand Scribe all the property of the Council, including, without limitation, all the books, records, jewels, paraphernalia, and funds or assets thereof.

ARTICLE VIII - CONFLICT DISCLAIMER

Anything contained in these By–Laws in conflict with the Statutes of the Grand Council of Knight Masons of the United States of America is hereby declared null and void.

ARTICLE IX - COUNCIL FUNDS

All Council funds shall be kept in the name of the Council in a financial institution in which the funds are federally insured. (such as F.D.I.C. etc.)

ARTICLE X - AMENDMENTS

These By–Laws may be amended at any meeting of the Council by a 2/3 majority vote of those members present if written notice has been given to the membership at least 30 days prior to the meeting where action is to be taken. Such By–Laws shall become effective when signed by the M.E. Great Chief. (See Article XVIII of the STATUTES).
